Admissions Requirements for the Associate of Science in Nursing Program

Educational Qualification: Applicants must hold a High School Diploma, whether domestic or international, or possess the equivalent of a General Education Diploma (GED).

Age Requirement: All applicants must be at least 17 years old or older at the time of application.

Enrollment Agreement Submission: Complete and submit the Enrollment Agreement. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the agreement must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Ensure submission within the registration period specified in the Institute's academic calendar.

Background Check and Fingerprint Compliance: Candidates must complete a Level II background check. Fingerprint compliance is mandatory.

Vaccination, Testing and Physical Examination:

Applicants must provide evidence of the following vaccines: Hepatitis B, Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis, Varicella, Influenza, Measles, Mumps, and Rubella.

Applicants must provide evidence of the following Test: Tuberculin Skin Test

Applicants must undergo a physical examination conducted by a qualified healthcare provider to ensure they are physically and mentally capable of performing nursing duties and are free of communicable diseases. The cost of the physical exam is the responsibility of the applicant.

*Candidates are responsible for covering the costs associated with these requirements. Failure to meet any of these health-related requirements will result in ineligibility to start the program.

Interview with Nursing Program Student Counselor: Applicants will undergo an interview with the Nursing Program Student Counselor to assess their ability to successfully complete the program within the specified 17-month timeframe, as well as to evaluate their commitment, vocation, and desire for a career in nursing. Based on the results of said interview, NPTI will determine the acceptance or not of the student into the ASN program.

English Language Proficiency: Applicants are required to take an Entrance Exam to determine their English language proficiency level. A minimum score of Advance level (73-100) is necessary to qualify for enrollment in the ASN Program at NPTI.

Acceptance Notification: Applicants will be notified of their acceptance status within three (3) business days after all required information is received and qualifications are evaluated. Applicants should review and adhere to all admission requirements and procedures carefully to ensure eligibility for the ASN program at New Professions Technical Institute.

***Nursing Concentration Course Failure:** Only one repeat of the SAME nursing concentration course (NUR) is permitted for students enrolled in the nursing program. A second failure of the SAME nursing concentration course (NUR) will result in the student being dismissed from the nursing program. Failing three nursing concentration courses (NUR) of any combination, including courses repeated, will result in the student being dismissed from the nursing program.

***General Education Course Failure:** Only one repeat of the SAME general education course is permitted for students enrolled in the nursing program. A second failure of the SAME general education course will result in the student being dismissed from the nursing program. Failing three general education courses of any combination, including courses repeated, will result in the student being dismissed from the nursing program.
